- MS is a disease of the brain and spinal cord, but its exact cause is unknown
- Nearly 400,000 individuals in the United States are affected by MS
- Adults between the ages of 20 and 40 have the highest incidence rate
- Symptoms vary and may include:
 - o Visual difficulty
 - o Speech problems
 - o Weakness or fatigue
 - o Partial or complete paralysis
 - o Poor circulation
 - o Numbness
 - o Bladder dysfunction
- New treatments are available to reduce the number and severity of relapses, as well as relieve many symptoms of this disease
